Operational Updates

- Ⓛ There are GDPR issues to be resolved by some of the portals, and we will follow up with them. EU-US Privacy shield invalidation. The collapse of this agreement means that we cannot use APPS that process user data outside the EU.
- Ⓛ There are ongoing improvements of automatic monitoring of Web Services and other tools within EMODnet. This is being done with a view to improving CP services.
- Ⓛ Repatriation updates. In addition to the centralization project the CP portal is being moved to the europa.eu domain. This requires a number of tasks to be carried out and some web development, the web development will be done by Trust-IT in cooperation with VLIZ (by the end of January 2021).

- 📡 **Ongoing Support to EU Atlas of the Seas.**
- 📡 **EMODnet Secretariat and VLIZ have created a tech team dedicated to the Central Portal as well as general EMODnet tech issues. In preparation for the new phases of EMODnet the team has established a number of operational support practises (Jira, OGC webservice uptime monitoring etc.)**
