

# Chapter 1 - European Union overview

## General figures

- The European Union has a coastline of 136 106 km. The EU is surrounded by three seas: the Mediterranean, the Baltic and the North Sea and by one Ocean, the Atlantic. The EU's coastal zone (within a range of 10 km from the coast) is 416 446 km<sup>2</sup>.
- The EU's coastal regions' size is 1 772 768 km<sup>2</sup>. 199.35 million EU citizens live in these regions (2006 data), resulting in an average population density of 108 inhabitants per km<sup>2</sup>.
- Coastal regions are key economic development generators. In 2005 they generated EUR 4 200 million of gross added value, while economic activities resulted in the employment of some 67 million people. The latter corresponds to 35.5% of the total employed labour force in all the EU-22 coastal Member States.
- The EU protects 78 282 km<sup>2</sup> of marine sea areas. This area represents 4.9% of the total marine protected areas worldwide (2007 data)<sup>(1)</sup>. EU has 14 345 bathing sea areas of which 77.5% comply with guide values on water quality. Another 19.1% comply with mandatory values. However, 2.8% of all bathing sea areas are not complying with any of the above standards. Finally bathing is outright prohibited in 0.5% of the total bathing sea areas (2006 data).

## Significant Economic Activities

- The GDP per inhabitant in the EU coastal regions amounted to an average EUR 24 294 (2005 prices). This GDP is 5.7% higher than the average GDP per inhabitant in the entire EU-22 coastal Member States. The highest annual GDP is observed in the North Sea region (EUR 32 342 per inhabitant), followed by the Atlantic Ocean region (EUR 24 673 per inhabitant), the Baltic Sea region (EUR 23 617 per inhabitant) and the Mediterranean Sea region (EUR 20 777 per inhabitant).
- The average unemployment rate in the EU coastal regions amounted to 6.5%, translating in 4.65 million persons. The majority of the unemployed workforce (about 50% according to 2006 data) are inhabitants of the Mediterranean Sea coastal region.
- Tourism is among the major economic sectors in the EU coastal areas. Almost 96 000 hotel units are located in these areas. 39.7% of the hotel units are located in the Mediterranean Sea region, 36.5% in the Atlantic Ocean region.
- Considerable leisure boating infrastructures also exist: approximately 3 000 marinas have an estimated capacity of about 1 million berths<sup>(2)</sup>.
- The fishing sector is a large employer in the EU as 250 451 persons were working in this sector (2006 data). In 2006 the sector produced 4.92 million tonnes of marine animals. 75% of the total marine animals were caught in the North-east Atlantic, while 11% came from the Mediterranean and Black Sea.
- The significant aquaculture activity in coastal regions accounts for 19% of the total EU marine animals' production.

- Almost 90% of the EU external trade and 40% of the EU's internal trade is using maritime transportation and hence passes through EU ports. In 2005, the extra- and intra-EU imports passing through EU ports were valued at EUR 736.2 billion, while the equivalent figure for exports stood at EUR 660.87 billion.
- There are more than 1 200 ports in the EU coastal regions. In 2006, 399 million passengers were counted in EU ports while cargo traffic reached 3.528 billion tonnes. The inwards/outwards ratio amounted to being 1.74.
- Agriculture is another economic activity developed in the EU coastal regions. In 2005 the sector contributed EUR 103.8billion in gross value added, or 51.9% of the gross value added produced by the agriculture sector in the EU-22 coastal Member States. The proportion of the arable land is 51.5%, while the livestock density stands at an average 30 units per holding (2005 data).





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





#### Exports



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
## Average annual growth rate of intra-EU and extra-EU trade by 1999-2005, based on value


