



Data preparation for EMODnet





Seabed Habitats: Detailed guidance notes on specific data preparation and INSPIRE metadata. Removal of topological errors (e.g. overlaps) is most time consuming part.



Chemistry: Mainly within our SeaDataNet processes – although some via ICES



Biology: New process for us in 2021. National IPT server host not set up to receive Darwin Core. E-mail submissions to DASSH and iterate QC/QA.



Physics: Not a direct contribution, however Galway Bay cable observatory; tide gauge and weather buoy data pulled from local Erddap data server




