- Regarding National funding, ECIMAT has its own budget (200.000 €/year) and received 625.000 € from national funding between 2008 and 2011.

- On February 8th 2012 Galician Official Diary published the order that regulates the new Competitive Research Units Consolidation Program (DOG 27-February 8th 2012) through which funding will be made available to continue the work started in 2008.
