


# First generation of integrated CBC between Member States and Partner countries: ENPI CBC 2007-2013

- As from 2007 ENPI CBC Fully integrated projects with one contract covering both sides of the borders
- Single set of rules
- Pooled ERDF/ENPI funding
- Total budget: 950 m EUR (ERDF + ENPI)

### Cooperation area


- Participating countries: Cyprus, Egypt, France, Greece, Jordan, Israel, Italy, Lebanon, Malta, Palestine, Portugal, Spain, Syria (participation currently suspended) and Tunisia
- Population: 110 million in 14 countries and 76 regions
- Budget ENPI 2007-2013: € 200 million



### 3 Calls for proposals:

95 approved projects Total value: € 205 million

### So far, CBC in a nutshell:

- High quality project implementation (confirmed by external monitoring)
- Strong comitment at all levels (programme & project) despite a difficult context (political crisis etc)
- "CBC" impact to be reinforced (new programmes more targeted)
- Capacity building needs at Local level in Partner countries



## Projets exemples in the maritime field:

### 1. CUSTOM MED - How to improve trade between the EU and the Middle East

- Simplified and harmonised customs procedures between Aqaba, Beyrouth, Gênes, Pireus and Alicante harbours
- Better integration and use of l'Information Technologies
- Capacity building of customs officiers and harbour administrations
- Speed up merchandise circulation by faster, simplified and better organised customs porcedures
- Budget: € 1M



### 2. FISHINMED: Mediterranean network for small fishermen communities



- Technical assistance to small fishermen communities to diversify activities and reinforce competitivity in the fishing sector
- Pilot projets for socio-economic developpement of small fishermen communities
- Promotion o fishermen communities in the Mediterranean
- Beneficiaires: Italy, Tunisia Egypt, Lebanon, Greece
- Budget: € 1.4M



## 3. MARE NOSTRUM: Integrated management of coastal Zones (IMCZ) to reduce legal and institutional barriers



- Development of alternative tools to improve the implementation of IMCZ by putting in place a Public Geographic Information System
- To identify institutional and administrative legal obstacles hampering set up of IMCZ policies at local level in the participating countries
- Beneficiaires: Greece, Spain, Israel, Jordan, Malta
- Budget: € 4.3M



### ENI Méditerranéen 2014-2020

- Total budget: 209m
- Thematic objective: Environmental protection, climate change adaptation and mitigation
  - Priorities:
    - Water
    - Waste
    - Renewable energy and energy efficiency
    - Integrated Coastal Zone Management
