Thematic lot's consortium and SMEs to review the map viewer and its functionality.

CP team to make a final review and confirm the switch to one CP

Until the switch to CP is final, thematic portals stay on and operate as normal. Caveats, the switch will be dependent on remaining noncritical fixes.

Phase 1 process: Week of October 17, 2022

The goal is to switch on the new static web content on CP portal

- EMODnet secretariat will supply the thematic portals with text to place in a banner on their websites informing users that they are in transition to a new centralised EMODnet and that users can preview their new thematic portal by navigating with the link provided.
- Central Portal (CP) team places a disclaimer in the new CP that states that we are going through
 major updates and that users can expect to access a new map viewer and data product download
 service later this year and that it will replace the services of the multiple EMODnet portals from 2023
 onwards
- Thematic portals stay on and operate as normal.

Phase 2 action plan: Week of November 21, 2022


The goal is to switch on new map viewer and download service on CP

- EMODnet secretariat will supply the portals with some text to place in a banner on their websites informing users that they are in transition to a new centralised EMODnet and that users can preview their new thematic portal and map viewer by navigating with the link provided.
- CP team produces a one-page guide on how to use the map viewer and how to download the data. This guide should show what functionality is currently available.
- CP team to invite the thematic lot's consortium and SMEs to review the map viewer and its download functionality.
- Bilbomatica fixing the list of minor issues.
- Thematic portals stay on and operate as normal.

Phase 3 action plan: Week of December 12, 2022

The goal is for the CP team to make a final review and confirm the switch to one CP

- EMODnet secretariat will supply the portals with text to place in a banner on their websites informing users that they are in transition to a new centralised EMODnet and that users can preview their new thematic portal and map viewer by navigating with the link provided.
- CP team produces a one-page guide on how to use the map viewer and how to download the data.
 This guide should show what functionality is currently available.
- We invite the thematic lot's consortium and SMEs to review the map viewer and its download functionality.
- Caveats, the switch will be dependent on remaining noncritical fixes.
 - Bilbomatica fixing the list of minor issues.
- If fixes not completed, we will delay the switch over by a few days until Bilbomatica fixes remaining minor issues
