Thematic Working Groups (TWGs) will discuss current challenges to ocean governance and identify concrete solutions. TWGs will be organised according to the EU's International Ocean Governance Agenda:

The meeting is structured in three consecutive steps:

- A plenary start that clarifies among all TWG members (a) expectations, (b) the governance (including support provided by the secretariat) and (c) the logic of work of the TWG from the identification of challenges to the identifications of solutions.
- TWG 1 Improving the international ocean **governance framework**
- TWG 2 **Reducing pressure** on oceans and seas and creating the conditions for a **sustainable 'blue' economy**
- TWG 3 Strengthening the ocean **knowledge system**
- Parallel working group session where TWG members work on their own topic identifying in particular "solutions" (specifying for each what, at which scale, by whom, which preconditions for success, etc.)
- A plenary consolidating session where outcomes of the individual TWGs are shared and discussed, identifying in particular synergies among them and issues that have been left open requiring further work. This plenary session will also help agreeing on the next steps of the process.
