
Schengen Area

- Operational in Warsaw since Oct. 05



- European Border Surveillance Systems
- Communications & Information management
- Remote Sensing and Detection

Checks

- Implementation of VIS
- Use of e-passports
- Entry/Exit system based on biometrics

Surveillance User's Needs



- Platforms and sensors for the collection of data and information
- 24/7 all weather surveillance border and prefrontier
- Platforms and sensors to facilitate interception
- Systems to exchange information
- Systems to exploit the information and react quickly to evolving threats
- All the above: Affordable and Integrable

EUROSUR objectives



Support MS authorities in improving situational awareness and increasing reaction capabilities with the aim to:

- reduce the number of illegal migrants entering EU <u>undetected;</u>
- reduce the <u>death</u> toll of migrants at sea;
- increase internal <u>security</u> by preventing cross-border crime.
- **3 Phases:** national, common tools, joint surveillance

EUROSUR Challenges



Challenges at Local/Regional/National Level

- Sharing Information within MS
- Improving Detection Capabilities (small craft)
- Merging sensor data and intelligence information

Challenges at Multinational/ EU Level

- Merging pre-border intelligence information
- Sharing 'common interest' information

EUROSUR First Steps: Pilot Project




- No central node in the network
- Only 'common interest' information exchanged
- Frontex may see only part of the info shared.
- All NCCs will be connected in 3 overlapping projects
- 'Solidarity' & 'Sprit de Corps'
- Flexible extensible solution helping to develop processes and behaviors

Connection of 6 NCCs & FRONTEX in a secure network.


