An inclusive framework for enhancing coordination and connection of Europe's ocean observing capability:

- From physics to biogeochemistry and biology;
- From automated monitoring to citizen science;
- Driven by stakeholders, for stakeholders/users;
- Building and aligning with existing efforts.



Why EOOS?



Added value: Connect and align stakeholder communities and observing programmes to make a more efficient, fit-for-purpose system that is sustainable to underpin the rest of the ocean observing value chain.

EOOS Vision: To have by 2030, a coordinated and connected end-to-end European ocean observation community that promotes European leadership, innovation and sustainability for in water ocean observation, driven by stakeholders, for stakeholders, serving the needs of science and society.

Who is EOOS?





