1. Three key messages

. Public Workshop framed on the assumption that spatial planning and coastal risck management in this hydrographic region are issues of major strategic

relevance not evident on the perspectives unfold by the main users but also by the evidences brought to the fore by future scenarios of coastal evolutions and the way planning and management processes must equate and attend to.

. The debate is focused into three main approaches. One related to the views and expectations of the main users - local council, port and seashore economic activities, another related to the evidences of scientific work on coastal evolution and associated risks, and finally, another related to the balances made out of recent planning and management experiences as well as challenges to the future, having in mind likely climatic changes and associated effects in the coastal strip. It is expected a relevant contribution for the revision of coastal spatial plan now in progress.
