
JIRA Status update

 - It exists in isolation on VLIZ servers.
 - We are going live this week!

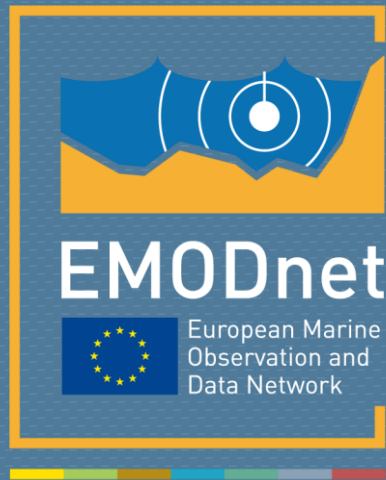
JIRA Status update
