
Online Survey 2021: Objective & Approach


- **Objective** Online Survey = strengthen interpretation of how the marine and maritime communities:
 - ➤ Use EMODnet as it exists (quality, user-friendliness, content, fit-for-purposeness of data & products)
- User survey launched online for 2 months (3 May 9 July)
- EUSurvey tool: https://ec.europa.eu/eusurvey/home/welcome
- 21 main questions (single & multiple choice; open questions)



Online Survey 2021: Results – Identification survey respondents


• **59** respondents completed the questionnaire






Online Survey 2021: Results – Accessibility EMODnet services

• More than 40% of the respondents "prefer not to register to access and download data, but it would not stop them"



Online Survey 2021: Results – Use & Quality EMODnet services

- 83% find it easy to navigate the Central Portal
- The **Map Viewer** is most popular key service (**32.5**%)
- 62% assessed quality of key services to be good



Online Survey 2021: Results – Use & Quality EMODnet services

Do you feel any specific dataset, product, or service is missing in EMODnet?
 34% indicated yes.

Data/products (missing):


- ➤ More data in coastal areas
- > Access to historical data
- More datasets in Black Sea
- ➤ High-resolution **Bathymetry**
- > Too low ratio 'produced biological data / biological data'
- ➤ Marine litter accumulation (chemistry)
- > Detail **geological** maps
- > Data related to fishery (HA)
- > Short-term predictions from **Physics** observations
- > Sea bottom sediment samples
- ➤... (many more)

Services (missing):


- ➤ Web-download service or Opendap NetCDF with compression
- ➤ Increased updating services to data of frequent change
- ➤ Increased availability services supporting feature/vector structures and coverage/grid structures
- ➤ Increased cross-thematic interoperability on data content level

• Shapefile preferred download format




• **GIS** preferred method to use data






Online Survey 2021: Recommendations

Reinforcement recommendations of the OS 2020

- Importance of access to high-quality visualisation tools
- Stable access to web services
- Complete and qualitative **metadata**, among others:
 - data provenance
 - data product creation transparency
 - last edit/update
- Interoperability







Targeted Assessment 2021: Objective & Approach

- Objective: understand better what industry needs from EMODnet going forward
- Approach: EU Survey tool questionnaire
 + follow-up interview
- 12 (of the 22 people asked), completed
 EU Survey and interviewed
- 11 interviewees from European Member
 State
- 1 interviewee from UK

Percentage (%) Geographic Representation, i.e. the Location of Organisation Head-Quarters




Targeted Assessment 2021: Results – Blue Economy Sub-Sectors



Targeted Assessment 2021: Results – Main modes of use of EMODnet






Targeted Assessment 2021: Main Messages and Recommendations

➤ Win-win scenarios for EMODnet-industry collaborations

- Most interviewees: moderate motivation to become data provider
- Suggestions improving ingestion process:
 - Uptake of data by users
 - Tagging of data
 - Demonstrate added value
- Visual map showing EMODnet data contributors & partners
 - > increase visibility
 - ➤ motivate becoming partner



Targeted Assessment 2021: Main Messages & Recommendations

> Metadata


- Complete and up-to-date metadata = critical & invaluable
- Often missing: origin & accessibility of (raw) data behind data products
- Minimise costs and planning efforts

> Data discoverability and visualisation

- Search data by location
- Data licenses
- High-level metrics of EMODnet offer (spatial coverage and data density & quality)

> Future outlook

- Workshops for new users → promote centralisation
- Role of EC Sustainable Finance Regulations in EMODnet (e.g., through metadata)
