- Federal Governmental Department
- * Multiple activities:
 - * Funding & support of 10 Federal Scientific Institutions (FSI)
 - * Coordination (national & international)
 - Management of Belgian participation in space research programmes
 - * Management of national research programmes
- * Annual Budget: Approx 570 M€
- Staff: Approx 2700 (incl FSI's)



Marine Research funding (1/2)



- * 1st marine research programme in 1970 (Project SEA)
- * Actual programme:

BRAIN-be - Belgian Research Action through Interdisciplinary Networks

- * End 2012 until 2017 (phase 1)
- Objectives: scientific support to federal competences (eg. North Sea) and federal scientific institutes (eg. RBINS)
- * Organised around 6 thematic axis:
 - * Axis 1: Ecosystems, biodiversity and evolution
 - * Axis 2: Geosystems, universe and climate
 - * Axis 3: Cultural, historical and scientific heritage
 - * Axis 4: Federal public strategies
 - * Axis 5: Major societal challenges
 - * Axis 6: Management of collections
- * Budget for whole programme: 117 MEURO

Earth Observation research programme (STEREO III)

- * 2014 2020
- * Budget : 28,6 M€
- * Research priorities:
 - * 1. Global monitoring of vegetation and evolution of terrestrial ecosystems
 - 2. Management of the environment on a local and regional scale (water, soil, forest, nature reserves and biodiversity, agriculture, coastal areas, urban and peri-urban areas)
 - * 3. Interaction between (change in) land cover and climate change
 - * 4. Epidemiology and humanitarian aid
 - * 5. Security and risk management

 - * Length +/- 65 m, width +/- 17 m
 - * Regional/sub oceanic RV
 - * Multipurpose
 - Ice class I (not ice breaker)
 - * +/- 300 d/yr at sea
 - * 24 scientists + 15 crew members
 - * Cost: +/- 50 M€
