



What does EMODnet already contribute to the goals and objectives of the UN Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development?

- Ocean Data and Information System (ODIS): All EMODnet thematic portals/central portal are registered on ODIS catalogue: In future can be maintained, and updated, and extended e.g. EMOD-PACE project
- IOC Ocean InfoHub Project (OIH): EMODnet contributing as a European focal point & technical advice to develop-ment of ODIS architecture & interoperability with EurOcean
- IWG-SODIS Intersessional Working Group Strategy on Ocean Data and Information Stewardship for the UN Decade: EMODnet invited as a contributor and expert
- UN Ocean Decade Actions: EMODnet contribution to COAST PREDICT, Ocean Best Practices, DITTO (Digital Twins)


