Main outcomes and key messages

The workshop in a nutshell

The objectives of the workshop were to present the youth's vision of the Youth4Ocean Forum and the benefits of becoming a member, and to start building collective actions. 153 participants of all ages, from universities, research centres, NGOs, science museums and aquariums of many different countries attended. Together they suggested collective actions that the Youth4Ocean Forum members can carry out, and how synergies can emerge with members of the EU4Ocean Platform and the Network of European Blue Schools. Virginijus Sinkevičius, Commissioner for Environment, Ocean and Fisheries, also attended and was invited to join the Youth4Ocean Forum as the first Honorary Member.

Key messages/main outcome(s)

The Forum will be a platform for mutual learning. We are as keen on learning from experts and decision-makers, as them to learn from us. But we want to be listened to and we want to create concrete changes.
