The European Marine Observation and Data Network (EMODnet) is financed by the European Union under Regulation (EU) No 508/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 15 May 2014 on the European Maritime and Fisheries Fund.

Status update: November 2020 - April 2021

- Main achievements
 - 25 new maps or groundtruth point datasets collated, processed and made available: Romania (7), Bulgaria (6), France (4), Greece (2), Italy (2), Norway (2), Ireland (1), Spain (1)
 - 3 composite data products uploaded: Habitats Directive Annex I in UK waters
 - 3 reports published
 - A review of stakeholder needs for combined, harmonized data products for seabed habitats in Europe (link)
 - Mapping seabed habitats over large areas: prospects and limits (<u>link</u>)
 - Method for classifying EUSeaMap according to the new version of EUNIS, HELCOM HUB and the Mediterranean habitat types (link)
 - A new nascent GeoServer infrastructure, for it to be "self healing", hence for service downtime to be reduced
- Challenges faced
 - Cookies policy
 - Personal data processing issue due to UK leaving the EU the 1st of January 2021 and JNCC processing personal data
 - Translation EUNIS 2007 -> EUNIS 2019 (lots of issues with the crosswalk proposed by the EEA)
 - COVID-19 (schools closed in the UK)



Cross-Thematic & external interactions


- EMODnet Biology: shared tasks on harvesting and filtering habitat point information in OBIS.
- EMODnet Geology
 - The Seabed substrate product is a key input to EUSeaMap
 - We met in February to agree on how Geology will deliver the data to Seabed Habitats
- HELCOM: in December 2020, we were invited to make a presentation at the HELCOM EN Benthic (Expert network on Benthic Habitats)
- ICES: collaboration to set up a new ICES geonetwork metadata account and subportal for EMODnet Seabed Habitats
- EEA
 - DG/MARE and the EEA organised a meeting between EMODnet Seabed Habitats and Biology and the EEA
 - We presented the data that we make available that is related to the Nature directives (e.g. our Habitats Directive Annex I individual maps from survey)
 - We have agreed that we will make available through M2M connections the latest version of their datasets on the conservation status of habitat types



Future Outlook

- EUSeaMap 2021 (September 2021)
- Products
 - Update of European maps of EOVs (essential ocean variables)
 - Seagrass
 - Macroalgal canopy
 - Coral
 - New Products
 - European map of biogenic habitats
 - Coralligenous and other calcareous bioconcretions in the Mediterranean
- More datasets made available
 - ~ 50 maps or point datasets
 - point habitat information stored in OBIS/ EMODnet Biology, harvested via M2M connections
- New 2-year contract starts 25/09/2021 (Coordination JNCC)
- Events
 - GEOHAB (05/2021)
 - SGEM 2021 (06/2021)
 - EMODnet Conference and Jamboree (2 posters)
