The UfM is chaired by two Co-Presidents, one from the North: the **European Union**, and a rotating one from the South: currently **Jordan**.


The Senior Officials

Based in Barcelona, it is led by a Secretary General, assisted by six Deputy Secretaries General for six priority areas. It is financed by the EC and contributions from member countries.

The UfM Secretariat acts as a one stop shop through which project promoters gain access to a strong network of donors and financial institutions, from the Mediterranean region and beyond.


Broker solution for complex regional projects

- Variable geometry allowing member countries to participate in projects of interest for them.
- **Regional and sub-regional integration** through large projects to develop transport, energy and water infrastructures variable geometry.
- **Dynamic and flexible partnerships** with promoters from public sector, civil society and private sector.
- **Concrete projects** to meet the needs of Mediterranean citizens.
- Adaptation to the current regional context with a focus on the development of SMEs and job creation.

UfM | Integrated Maritime Policy

Focus: regional and cross-sectoral aspects of IMP planning and implementation.

- Three UfMS Divisions involved:
 - Environment/Water
 - Transport and Urban Development
 - Energy

UfM | IMP - Main policy developments of interest

- Advancement of the Mediterranean region in the implementation of ICZM and MSP, as key IMP tools.
- Adoption in March 2013 of a EU draft proposal for a Directive establishing a framework for MSP and ICZM.
- The organisation of the UfM Ministerial meetings on Transport (November 2013), Energy (December 2013), and Environment and Climate Change (1st semester 2014)

UfM | possible way forward at regional level

UfM = an opportunity for IMP advancement



- Moving from a national to a cross-national dimension;
- Cross-sectoral planning; and/or
- Implementation via concrete projects of regional relevance, also at pilot scale
