Green Deal: a tool for many things

- When innovations that pop up from society are actually put into practice, but encounter thresholds
- Central Government closer to companies, stakeholder organizations and interest groups
- Gives government a more readily identifiable presence and the other players a clear point of contact

Green Deal: 4 goals for 2020

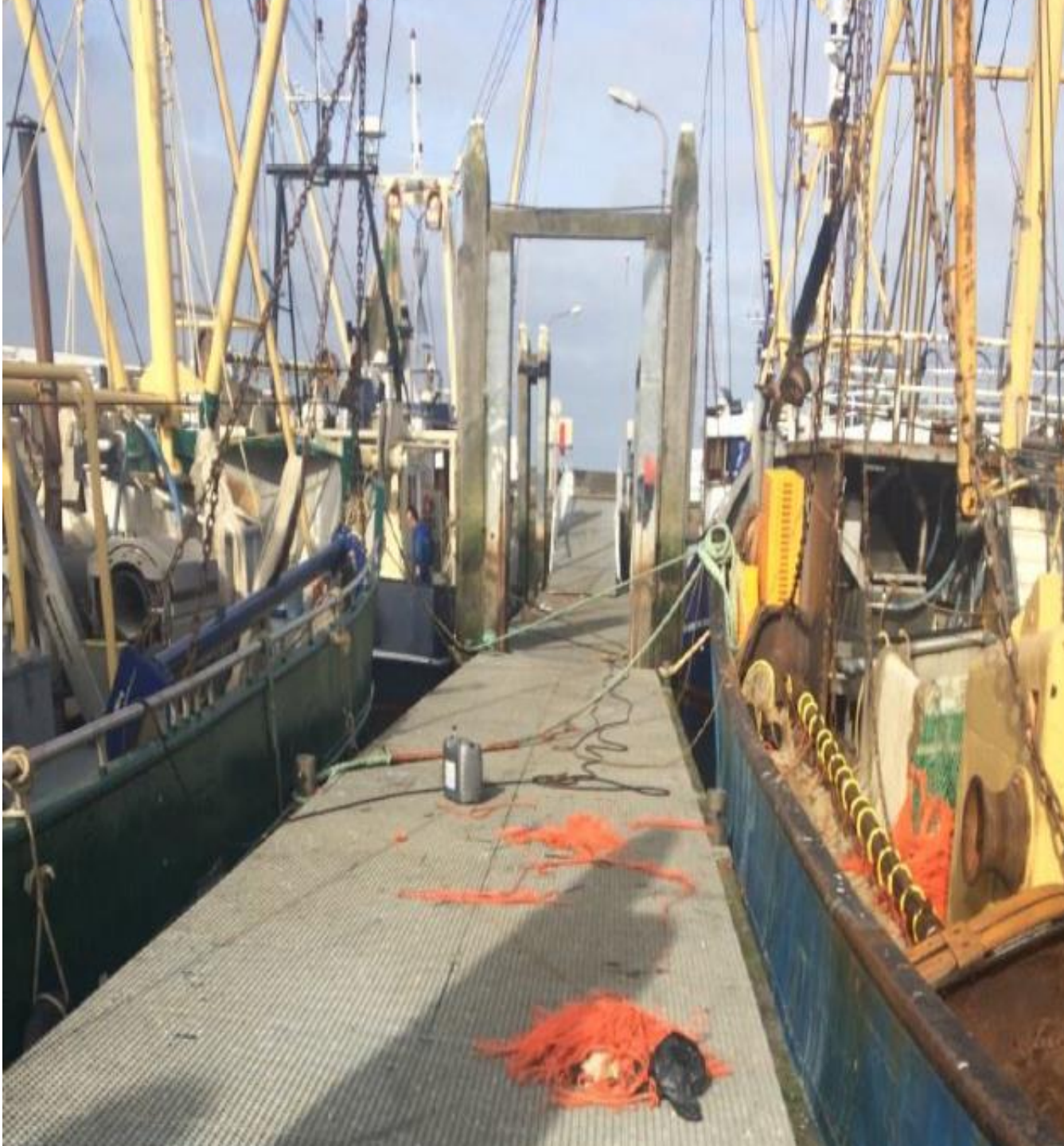
1. The fishing ships separate all the (1) household waste, (2) Fishing for Litter Waste and (3) industrial and fishing gear on board, and take these to the port
2. In 2016 five fishing ports facilitate the separate waste streams adequately and without delay. The three different waste streams are collected separately. In 2020 all the Dutch fisheries harbours meet this goal
3. The current Fishing for Litter program is to be continued and its size, where possible, expanded
4. In 2020 95% of the industrial waste (fishing gear) and Fishing for Litter waste, that is brought upon shore by fisheries ships, is recycled or applied usefully

Green Deal and PRF

- Waste facilities in ports
- Solutions for Passively fished up waste and monitoring
- Requires cooperation between fishermen, ports, waste collectors / recyclers



Green Deal and SUP

- Extended Producer Responsibility on Fishing Gear
- Challenges on design, collection, use and recycling of fishing gear
- Calls for awareness measures
- Requires cooperation between fishermen, ports, waste collectors, recyclers, NGO's and central government and ofcourse producers



Green Deal - PRF and SUP?

- Establishes a network
- Synergy between SUP and PRF
- More willingness from participating parties



Relevancy for the marine litter problem

- You need voluntary cooperation, from everybody
- Impossible to audit all the ships on open sea
- Goodwill essential in preventing marine litter



Conclusion
