Introduction

The Commission (DG MARE) launched annual calls for project proposals opened to national authorities

- Under the European Maritime and Fisheries Fund (EMFF) for 2014-2020
- Budget set aside to support the integration of maritime surveillance at national level and across MS
- Managed by EASME Executive Agency for Small and Medium-sized Enterprises

Objective: To foster the information exchange across sectors and borders by supporting the improvement of IT interoperability between national authorities' systems



Calls for Projects

2014 Call (4,590,000 EUR)

- 7 projects (ES, FI, GR, PT, RO)
- 1-2 years
- From Jan 2016 to Dec 2017

2015 Call (2,538,000 EUR)

- 3 projects (BG, CY, ES, GR)
- 1-2 years
- From Jan 2017 to Dec 2018


2016-2017 Call (2,490,000 EUR)

- Projects will start in Jan 2018 until Dec 2019





