

Status update


- Successful EMODnet Bathymetry 2018-2020
- EMODnet Bathymetry 2020-2022 awarded and signed (12/2020) + renewing of the consortium agreement
- Kick off (7-9/04/21) Metadata Workshop
- Current progression on metadata population (new survey) + migration towards CC-BY licenses (from data providers)
- Globe Workshop (6/09/2021)
- Progress on the migration from EMODnet Bathy portal to central portal: Monthly meeting, with priorization of services to be implemented, knowledge sharing (code) and first prototypes

- Participation in one of the Digital Twin of the Ocean proposal








Future Outlook

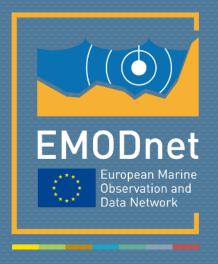
- Progress on the update of the full DTM and HRDTM

 - Bathymetric data sampling (till end 21)
 - Compilation at regional level (summer 22)
 - Global compilation (release end of 22)

 - Continuation of implementation of existing EMODnet Bathy services
 - Acceptance tests
- Events to come:
 - Participation at the Meso-American Marine Spatial Data Infrastructure WG (22/09)
