






### NATURAL DISASTERS ARE COSTLY

Economic damage caused by weather and climate-related events in Europe



- Meteorological events: storms;
- Hydrological events: floods, mass movements;
- Climatological events: heatwaves, cold waves, droughts, forest fires.

Small number (3 %) of events responsible for large proportion (> 60 %) of the economic losses

Average annual losses were around: 6.6 billion in 1980-1989, 12.3 billion in 1990-1999, 13.2 billion in 2000-2009, 12.5 billion in 2010-2019.

Enhancing society's resilience to climate change through a focus on prevention, preparedness, response and recovery will be key to the EU's revised adaptation strategy
