Our view on: Common EMODnet reference coastline

- ⦿ Think it's a good idea for creation of new products – a common and predictable extent for broad-scale habitat map (EUSeaMap), DEM and substrate layer.
- ⦿ Collation of existing habitat maps from surveys: these should retain their existing coastline.



Our view on: Feeding project data into EMODnet

- ⦿ Action 6: “DIP and all EMODnet portals to consider advice to major funding programmes to ensure direct feed of generated project data into EMODnet...”
- ⦿ MEDISEH example
- ⦿ Funders should specify (precisely) in the tender spec:
 - ⦿ That outputs must be made freely available for public and commercial use – and check compliance.
 - ⦿ The repository through which to publish outputs – and check compliance.
