




## WP5 Aims

- Vessel traffic density.




# WP5 Expected Outcome – Milestones and Deliverables

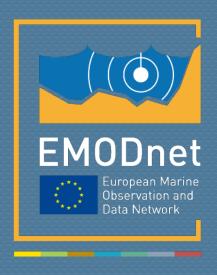
Milestone 5.1. Digital map available on line. Formats and standards agreed for parameters (M12)
