Maritime Economy has undergone profound, comprehensive transformations over the last decade, affecting production and commercialization strategies in the sector. The current scenario – showing **an increasingly high level of specialization** in some of the competitors while new producers are entering the scene, typically from South-East Asia – requires **customized, targeted training** of human resources operating in the field, **with a multiregional and transnational scope**, involving not only management, but also those with more operative positions and working for maritime agents, brokers, shipping companies, shipyards, insurance companies, Port Authorities and port-based transportation and logistics companies, etc.

Such context led to the idea of **an international maritime symposium** entitled '*Structural measures and policies for the outlining of new maritime career paths and professional skills*'.
