Next Steps

- May 2023: Kick-off meeting (16 May 2023) with service provider, design Conference visuals, finalize Conference title and high-level programme (after 18th SC)
- June 2023: Open the Call for Registration, Call for (e-)poster abstracts (for Virtual Exhibition and on-site exhibitors (max 20 tables for networks/initiatives), develop mature draft programme, send invitations to speakers
- July-August 2023: Second wave invitations, assess poster and exhibitor applications, development of Virtual Exhibition content
- September October 2023: Make public the mature draft programme, development of Jamboree session cross-thematic programmes, finalize Virtual Exhibition content, prepare session/panel briefings, promotion of sessions and speakers
- November 2023: Finalising program and all speakers
