Centres of Vocational Excellence *Key success factors*

- Linked to strategies for regional development, innovation, smart specialisation, clusters, social inclusion...

 Identification of synergies between policies and amongst stakeholders.

 Co-creating skills-ecosytems that support strategic development objectives.
- Strong and enduring partnerships
 Between VET providers, higher education institutions, businesses, public employment services, etc. in which interactions are mutually beneficial

 CoVEs achieve more than the sum of the parts.



Centres of Vocational Excellence Erasmus+ funding under Partnerships for Excellence (Ka2)

- > **2021-2027:** €400 million for 100 networks of CoVE
- > **Applicant**: Any organisation established in a E+ Programme Country
- Partners: Any public or private organisation active in field of VET, or world of work. Can be from any country in the world, but non-programme partners must bring an 'essential added value'
- > **Partnership:** at least 8 full partners from a minimum of 4 Programme
 - a) at least 1 enterprise, industry or sector representative organisation, and
 - b) at least 1 VET provider (at secondary and/or tertiary level)
- **EQF levels:** Can be at any EQF level but must include levels 3, 4 or 5
- > Maximum grant: €4 million per project with 4 year project duration
- > Erasmus+ 2022 call: Deadline for project applications 7 September 2022



The BRIDGES network of CoVEs aims to provide flexible responses to the training, innovation and entrepreneurship needs of the finfish industry, with a strong emphasis on the modernisation and digitalisation of work-based learning and apprenticeships





Innovative VET

Develop and test a new and innovative system that makes VET more accessible to company staff in the aquaculture industry and others who want a job in the industry.

This applies to initial qualifications, further education and shorter courses for in-company training, allowing VET providers to be more responsive in delivering training based on continuous needs of the aquaculture industry



Aquaculture Skills Foresight Establishment of the European Aquaculture Skills Foresight Forum with industry involvement, influence and leadership, to inform 'down-stream' collaborative VET developments.

It will also provide VET providers with knowledge on current and anticipated aquaculture needs and allow prioritization of local business innovation support activities

A Common Competence Framework

Develop a common competence framework (CCF) for finfish production, aimed for the husbandry operative and site manager levels for cold water finfish farming.

The process will be led by industry but supported by VET partners experienced in the development of knowledge skills and competences for each occupational level
