

How to get to EMODnet Secretariat Office

Location and how to get there:

The EMODnet office is located in the InnovOcean site which is situated in former warehouses of the fish auction hall of Ostend on the eastern bank of the port, opposite the city centre.

The easiest way to get to the EMODnet Office and Meeting Rooms at the InnovOcean site from the Ostend Station is by taxi (approximately 10 minutes). You should indicate the door number (68) to the driver, as the warehouse is a long building.

Recently, a free ferry service connects the city centre (walking distance from the Station) with the eastern-bank of the harbour (walking distance from the EMODnet Office). Regular ferries operate every day from 6:30 till 21:00 in summer (April to September) and from 8:00 till 18:00 in winter (from October to March).

To get to Ostend from Brussels Airport and back: regular trains are running from the Brussels Airport level -1 (change in Brussels city) to Ostend and back. An up-to-date train schedule in English is available at: http://www.b-rail.be/main/E/

Door-to-door journey from EMODnet Office to the Airport takes approximately 2 hours. EMODnet Office — Ostend Station \sim 10min / Ostend Station — Brussels Airport = from 1.40 (via Brussels) to 2hrs (via Gent).
