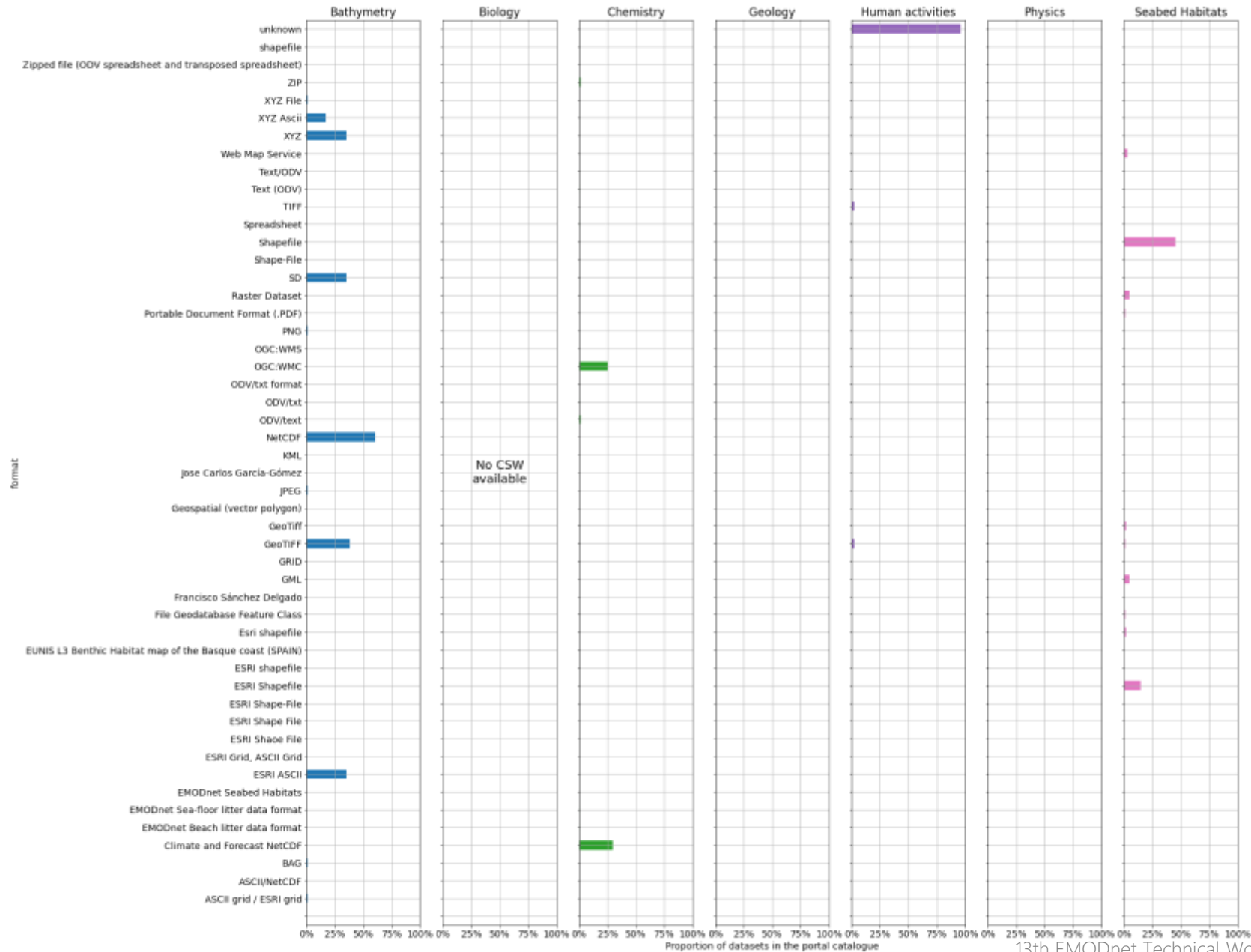

 - EU DATA
 - INSPIRE PORTAL

- Aim: Discuss best approach to further harmonize EMODnet metadata

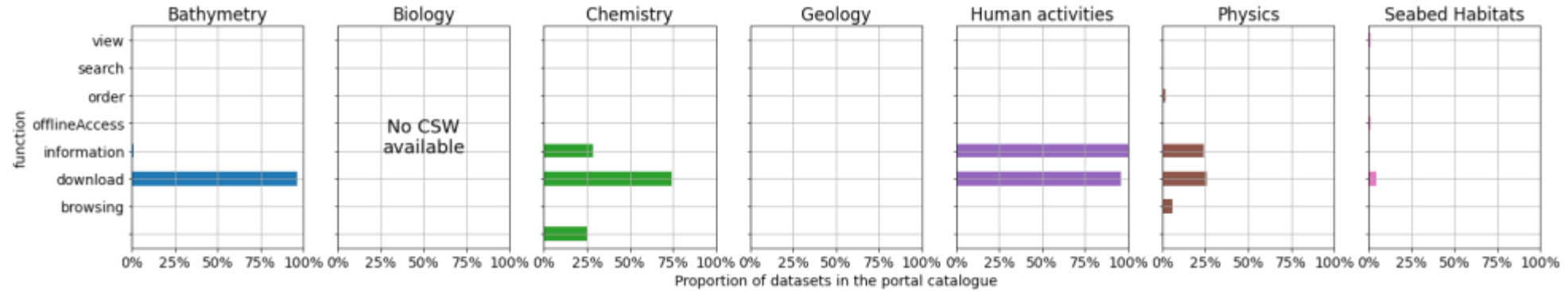
Source of data for the metadata analysis

Distribution Information: Format

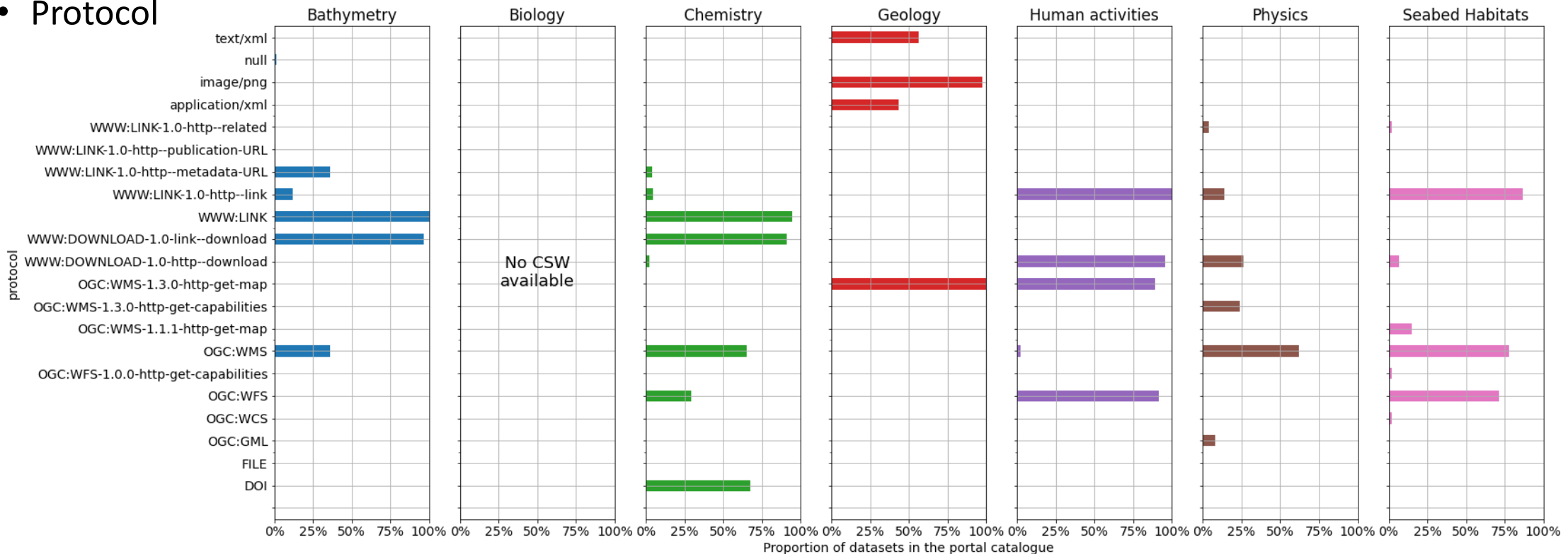


Distribution Information: Transfer Options

- Function (controlled vocabulary)

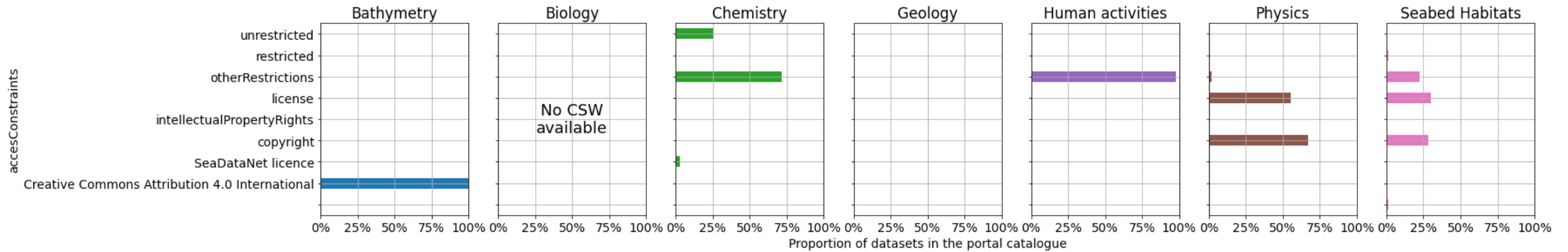


- Protocol

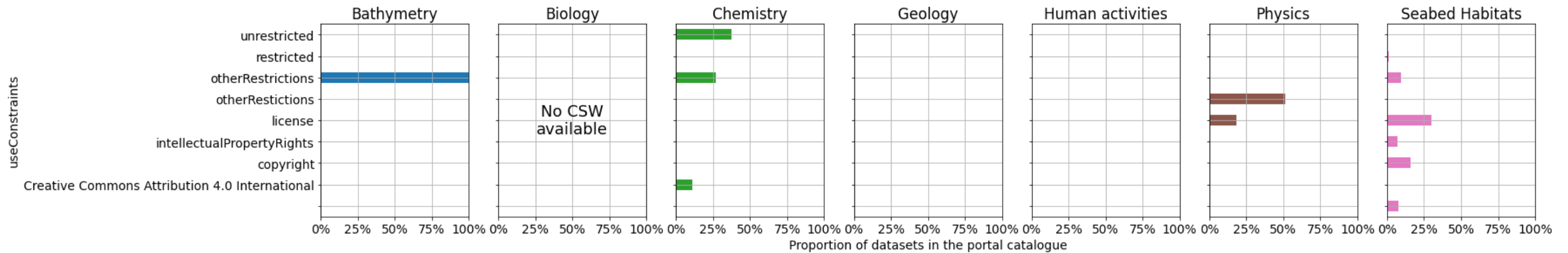


Constraints

- Access Constraints (controlled vocabulary)

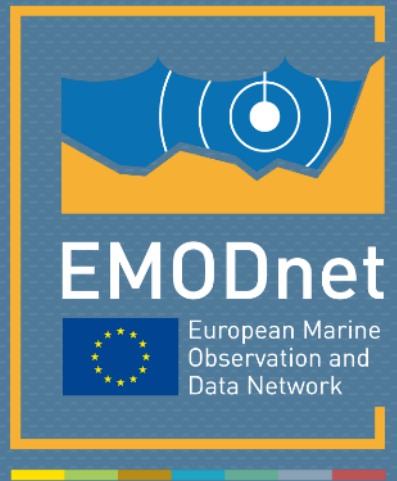


- Use Constraints (controlled vocabulary)

 - INSPIRE implementation
 - Set Use or Access Constrains to “OtherConstrains” (Check with text)
