Marine Strategy Framework Directive

- The Directive establishes a framework within which Member States shall take the necessary measures to achieve or maintain good environmental status in the marine environment by the year 2020 at the latest.
- For that purpose, Marine Strategies shall be developed and implemented in order to:
 - (a) protect and preserve the marine environment, ...
 - (b) prevent and reduce inputs in the marine environment, with a view to phasing out pollution ...
- GMES initiative provides the framework that partially supports a Pan-European monitoring and forecasting system to provide the basic data sets required by the MFSD








Operational Meteorology: the results after 25 years












Operational oceanography: 10 years of quality increase





Now the currents can be taken from Myocean: waves and winds will be in the same portfolio soon










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








Marine and coastal environment: limited area modelling for the shelf and coasts


MyOcean disseminates daily forecasts to 13 nested national models every day

Marine and coastal environment: land pollution control








Marine and coastal environment: EEA eutrophication indices (ETC-Water, 2009)

•New Chlorophyll indicator based upon the MyOcean Ocean color data from 1998-2007

- •Spatial mapping of % of ChI content per year: indication of coastal eutrophication trends and open ocean productivity
- Indicator may suggest impact of implemented policies in the coastal areas
- Indicator may suggest climate-related changes In open ocean waters










